





Partnerships





Audience Members Reached

A total of 1,796,356 persons were reached through the conservation education programs and activities. 236,827 (13%) were reached directly, and another 1,559,529 were reported to be reached indirectly. Of the total audience members reported to be reached, 3.1% were identified as being from an urban environment, and 2.2% were considered to be audience members from a traditionally underserved population.
