





Partnerships


A total of 16 partnerships were created to support the 5 reported Conservation Education programs and activities.





The 5 Conservation Education Programs & Activities by Topic:




The 5 Conservation Education Programs & Activities by Type:



Audience Members Reached

A total of 161,621 persons were reached through the conservation education efforts of Region 10. 109,395 (67.6%) were reached directly, and another 52,226 were reported to be reached indirectly. Of the total audience members reported to be reached 4.1% were identified as being from an urban environment, and 43.2% were considered to be audience members from a traditionally underserved population.
