




A total of 132 partnerships were created to support the 35 reported Conservation Education programs and activities.







The 35 Conservation Education Programs & Activities by Topic:




A total of 73,270 persons were reached through the conservation education efforts of Region 1. 23,142 (32%) were reached directly, and another 50,137 were reported to be reached indirectly. Of the total audience members reported to be reached 8.5% were identified as being from an urban environment, and 15.5% were considered to be audience members from a traditionally underserved population.
