



A total of 46 partnerships were created to support the 11 reported Conservation Education programs and activities.






The II Conservation Education Programs & Activities by Type:



Audience Members

A total of 259,906 persons were reached through The conservation education efforts of Region 3. 40,322 (15.5%) were reached directly, and another 219,584 were reported to be reached indirectly. Of the total audience members reported to be reached 11.6% were identified as being from an urban environment, and 16.8% were considered to be audience members from a traditionally underserved population.
