







The 30 Conservation Education Programs & Activities by Topic:




The 30 Conservation Education Programs & Activities by Type:



A total of 966,017 persons were reached through the conservation education efforts of Region 8. 267,137 (27.7%) were reached directly, and another 698,880 were reported to be reached indirectly. Of the total audience members reported to be reached 2.1% were identified as being from an urban environment, and 11.6% were considered to be audience members from a traditionally underserved population.
