





Partnerships


A total of 48 partnerships were created to support the 12 reported Conservation Education programs and activities.

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

The 12 Conservation Education Programs & Activities by Topic:



A total of 106,278 persons were reached through the conservation education efforts of Region 9. 34,023 (32%) were reached directly, and another 72,255 were reported to be reached indirectly. Of the total audience members reported to be reached 22.3% were identified as being from an urban environment, and 6.4% were considered to be audience members from a traditionally underserved population.




