

Discounts for Seniors and Disabled at USDA Forest Service Campgrounds

Key Messages

- The Forest Service will not change current discounts provided to holders of passes at Forest Service campgrounds operated by private businesses.
- Seniors and people with disabilities who are pass holders will continue to receive a 50% discount at Forest Service campgrounds run by concessioners.
- The Forest Service had proposed changes to address growing challenges regarding services provided by private businesses at Forest Service recreation facilities.
- Holders of Golden Age and Golden Access Passports and Interagency Senior and Access Passes will continue to receive a 50 percent discount at campgrounds run by private concessions businesses.
- The Forest Service is grateful for the robust public response to the proposal. The agency received more than 4,000 comments on proposed changes to its concessions pass policy during the 60-day public notice and comment period.
- The Forest Service remains committed to ensuring the American public will continue to enjoy recreational opportunities on National Forests and Grasslands in years to come.
